## Extra Food for Children This Summer

During the summer months, the pantry distributes extra food to families with children to help offset the free school meals that they no longer receive. A few schools in High Point offer limited free meals in the summer but most children don't live close enough to walk to one of those schools. During June, the Food Pantry assisted **32 families** comprised of **49 adults** and **35 children** which provided enough food to prepare **540 individual meals**. We have sufficient inventory of dry beans so please donate other items in place of them. Our **MOST WANTED** list for July includes saltine crackers, corn, peas, ready-to-eat canned beans, and canned meats. 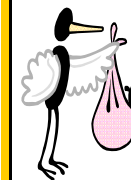
**How Does Our Garden Grow?**
